

## GENERAL RULES FOR THE USE OF CAMPING AREAS

**1º.-** Camping permits can be requested at The Citizen Attention and Information Office (OIAC) of the Cabildo of Gran Canaria, Str.C/Bravo Murillo, 23 acceso C/Pérez Galdós. The applications forms must be presented at least three days beforehand.

**2º.-** Permits will be granted for a 7 days period maximum. **The permit includes the night requested and the day after up to 12:00 a.m.**

**3º.-** Permits will be arranged by entrance order of application forms having preference those which have been processed for the first time.

**4º.-** Campers belonging to collective groups-with the objective of favouring contact and knowledge of nature-will have preference to obtain a camping permit.

**5º.-** For any incident in the camping areas, you must contact the Cabildo of Gran Canaria staff.

**6º.-** Please do not leave rubbish in the surrounding areas. Therefore, you must be provided with plastic bags to be placed in the areas suitable to this end.

**7º.-** Do not cut off tree branches and do not take fruits, avoiding walking and treading out of paths and tracks, except for the relaxation areas existing to this end, which will be signalled by the forest guard.

**8º.-** It is strictly forbidden to make fire outside the areas established for this purpose.

**9º.-** Do not walk on sown and cultivated lands.

**10º.-**We recommend you not to move around ravines and sides of the surrounding areas and not to cross them for risk of danger.

**11º.-** Do not practice activities which can disturb the group of campers. Thus it is not allowed to do any kind of noise, in particular engines, musical equipments or alike from 22:00 up to 8:00. **It is strictly forbidden to use engines at any time.**

**12º** In case of under 18s, you must avoid them from scattering. For this reason at least one adult must be responsible for each 20 minors, keeping them always under control and vigilance.

**13º.-** Applicants will watch over for the group's security and both him and the group will be jointly responsible for any damage or prejudice produced to other people or to the island's wealth, and the Cabildo will be exempt from any kind of responsibility.

**14º.-** Dogs must be always under the owner's direct control and as regards their excrements, we must act by virtue of article 6.

**15º.-** The Cabildo of Gran Canaria has the faculty to modify or cancel an authorization already given when it is suitable for the general interest.

**16º.-** In case of any doubt related to the above mentioned norms, you can consult the Cabildo staff, who will be at the visitor's disposal for any advice or help you will need.

**17º.-** Applicants must know the rules which regulate camping in natural protected areas and in particular, the 31<sup>st</sup> August 1993 and the 9<sup>th</sup> July 146/01 Decrees..

**18º.- Users must arrive at the camping areas before 23:00 p.m.**

This Corporation expects that all the authorised people will contribute with a positive attitude with regard to the aforesaid rules.
